Vocabulary

<u>culture</u> - the beliefs, customs, practices, and social behavior of a particular nation or people

<u>cultural universal</u> - basic behavior practiced by all cultures, regardless of location or time period

<u>mound</u> - a pile of earth, stones, or other material built up for a specific purpose

<u>pyramid</u> - any large structure with a square base and four sloping, triangular sides

chamber - room used for a specific purpose

<u>elite</u> - group regarded as the finest and most important part of a population, including its leaders

ritual - ceremonial act which follows certain rules or customs

artifact - any object made or used by humans

<u>tomb</u> - chamber used for burial of a dead person(s); monument to a dead person(s), often built over the place where the body or bodies is buried

sarcophagus - ancient stone coffin
